Invitation to the 34th Budgerigar European Championship 2018

From 25th to 26th August 2018 at the Schwarzwaldhalle
Festplatz 9 (Kongresszentrum) 76137 Karlsruhe

Programme of Events

Friday, 24th August 2018

14.00-18.00 h: Delivery of birds

The delivery of birds in person will take place at the entrance of the Schwarzwaldhalle.

Attention: After 18.00 h a delivery of birds is no longer possible! Road traffic congestion around Karlsruhe at least 1 hour should be taken into consideration. Dispatch of birds by rail is not permitted.

Exhibition birds from EU Member States, that are transported back to their country of origin, do not require any certificates. Exhibition birds from third countries (f.i. Suisse) require an official veterinary health certificate.

All budgerigar exhibitors are invited to participate in an international breeders' evening with buffet from 19.00 h after the delivery of their birds. For the first time this meeting will take place under the direction of the DWV in the Hotel-Restaurant Hoepfner-Burghof. (info: www.hoepfner-burghof.de) The Hoepfner-Burghof-Restaurant is located at Haid-und-Neu-Straße 18 in 76131 Karlsruhe, about 5 minutes by car from the Schwarzwaldhalle.

For organisational reasons, the participation fee of 20 € per person (for buffet) together with the participation fee of the budgies must have been transferred to the following DWV bank account by Friday, 17 August 2018 at the latest:

Rings: Birds with their own rings are permitted, these must be closed and undamaged. Additional colour rings are not permitted. They are regarded as unauthorised identification and lead to disqualification of the bird. The AZ shall not assume any liability for loss or damage during transport or the duration of the show. Attention! Manipulation/Identification at the ring resp. at the bird:

If a ring manipulation is detected, all birds of the exhibitor will be disqualified and he will initially be banned from AZ shows for an indefinite period. If manipulation is detected on the bird, all birds of the exhibitor will be disqualified and a ban will be imposed until 31 December of the following year. (see: "General show guidelines"). Manipulation of the birds/ring by non-members leads to the exclusion of all birds of the exhibitor. For veterinary reasons, the breeder number on the registration form must match the breeder number on the bird's ring. This is particularly important for members of several clubs or associations. If the breeder number on the registration form does not match the breeder number on the ring, the bird will be disqualified.

Budgerigars:

To be exhibited as single birds, pairs and collections, each divided into adult-/ youngbird and breeding sections "Champion" (CH) as well as "Beginner and Intermediate" sections (Z and F) and in case of the single birds additionally into cock and hen. Food (approx. 3 cm) must be available on the bottom of the cage. New since the show season 2017: All budgies have to be supplied with drinking water by the exhibitor! The drinking bowl must be fixed in the cage. The wide white bowls or all drinking tubes (max. 70ml) are permitted.

Registration and participation fees

The advance registration is very simple.

The participation fee (2.50 € per cage plus obligatory catalogue of 5.00 €) has to be paid with the pre-registration to the DWV-Chairman (see address below) no later than on the last day of the registration deadline. Please send a message (E-mail or by post) with your name (address) and only the number of the Show- or/and Colour-Budgerigars you want to exhibit to the DWV-Chairman by this date. A completed registration form (with all information about variety, sex and year of the exhibited birds) is not required until the day of delivery!) Bird market: is held in connection with the show. The same conditions apply as at the AZ-Nationalshow - there is no pre-registration of birds for sale.
